

## Talk on Mountain Casualty Handling

An Instructor Self-Enhancement Course on Mountain Casualty Handling organized by Expeditions Instructors Central Registration Unit was successfully held on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017 Friday at Civil Service Aid Headquarters. It was our honor to invite Mr. Louis Chow, ECSI Wilderness First Aid Instructor, to be our guest speaker. The talk attracted more than 140 instructors and assessors from different Operating Authorities.

Mr. Chow illustrated a systematic mountain casualty handling procedure called S.M.A.R.T.S. approach and shared knowledge about how to provide prompt and appropriate support to casualties with a lack of medical equipment in order not to worsen the situation.
