Criteria

1. Applicant should be aged 18 or above;
2. Priority will be given to those who are AYP participants, Award recipients, Award Leaders or AYP Volunteers.

Application Method

Applicant can register by filling out the Google Form at <https://forms.gle/WU6KY61q3FBcJth16> and follow the instructions to upload proof of payment and relevant documents, e.g. first-aid certification, other certifications (if any).

Payment

The course fee per participant is **HK\$3,000**.

Important Notes

1. Course fee is NON-REFUNDABLE once the application is accepted.
2. Participants successfully completed and passed the training will be invited to placement.
3. Based on attendance and performance in the course, the chief instructor will recommend the participants to be nominated as a Bronze or Silver Level Adventurous Journey instructor (Hiking).
4. Upon completion of training and placement, the participant should hold a valid first-aid certificate recognized by The Hong Kong Labour Department, such as issued by the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance, Hong Kong Red Cross, Auxiliary Medical Service etc., when applying to become an instructor.

5. Starting from 1 April 2026, all Central Registration Scheme (CRS) instructors are required to apply for Sexual Conviction Record Check (SCRC) and submit the result to the Award Office. Upon approval of the instructor registration, the Award Office will issue a Documentary Proof (volunteer) to the instructor applying for SCRC. The application cost will be borne by the Award Office.
